




### Sarojini Naidu

(Date of Birth: 13 February 1879)

(Date of Death: 2 March 1949)

Sarojini Naidu (1879–1949) was an Indian freedom fighter, poet, and the first woman to become president of the Indian National Congress and the first female governor of an Indian state (United Provinces). Born in a Bengali family in Hyderabad, she was educated in India and the UK, where she was involved in the suffragist movement. Influenced by Mahatma Gandhi, she became a key figure in India's independence struggle. Known as the "Nightingale of India", her poetry is celebrated for its vivid imagery and lyrical beauty, with "In the Bazaars of Hyderabad" being one of her most famous works.





To commemorate National Science Day, our students visited the Chemistry and Physics Lab for an engaging session of hands-on learning and exploration.








## LEARNING CENTRE






