Swami Vivekananda, born Narendranath Datta on January 12, 1863, was an Indian Hindu monk and the chief disciple of the mystic Ramakrishna. He played a key role in introducing Vedanta and Yoga to the Western world and raising interfaith awareness, making Hinduism a major global religion. He was influential in the revival of Hinduism in India and contributed to Indian nationalism during British rule. Vivekananda founded the Ramakrishna Math and Mission and is best known for his 1893 speech at the Parliament of the World's Religions in Chicago. His birthday is celebrated as National Youth Day in India, where he is regarded as a patriotic saint.

Bal Sanskar Diwas 4/1/2025


