Kalpana Chawla (1962-2003) was a prominent Indian-American astronaut and engineer, making her the first Indian woman to travel to space. She was born in Karnal, India, and became a naturalized US citizen, pursuing her education and career in the United States. Her first space mission was on the Space Shuttle Columbia in 1997, and she later flew on the STS-107 mission in 2003, which ended tragically in a disaster that killed all seven astronauts on board.


Recreational Day 01/03/2025


